THE ITINERARY

Day 1 Adelaide to Flinders Ranges (approx. 440km day)

Pick up location: Terrace Hotel, 208 South Terrace, at 7:00am.

Head out of the city through the picturesque Clare Valley wine region before heading into the Southern Flinders Ranges, where you'll be struck by the wondrous scenery that unfolds before you. Stretch the legs on a fantastic bush walk through Alligator Gorge and enjoy a picnic lunch under the shade of the Blue Gums.

Travel further north and come late afternoon, check into Rawnsley Park Station. Relax and freshen up before we take a short drive to Wilpena Pound for a Welcome to Country in the language of the Adnyamathanha people. Enjoy Aboriginal songs, traditional stories, and local information as you are welcomed to the Flinders Ranges. Following this special cultural experience, you will have dinner at the Wilpena Pound Restaurant.

Overnight: Rawnsley Park Station

Meals included: Lunch;Dinner

Day 2 Flinders Ranges (approx. 200km day)

Explore the Ikara-Flinders Ranges National Park and otherworldly Wilpena Pound. Take a two-hour walk to Wangara Lookout. This walk is a beautiful opportunity to see inside Wilpena Pound and see some wildlife. On this walk, you can also visit Hill's Homestead and learn the story of the early settlers who grew wheat inside Wilpena Pound.

After a picnic lunch, you'll have exclusive access to traditional lands with access granted by permission of the traditional custodians of the land, the Adnyamathanha people. Here you'll witness the 630-million-year-old geology of the area, including sites of cultural significance, and spot abundant wildlife. Head back to our accommodation for a tasty dinner

before another night in the outback.

Day 3 Flinders Ranges to Coodlie Park (approx. 480km day)

Saying farewell to the Flinders Ranges, this morning you will visit the Jeff Morgan Gallery in the tiny town of Hawker to see an incredible 360-degree immersive panorama of the ranges. You will also stop in Quorn, a historical town which came into existence as an important railhead. Its old-style charm has seen Quorn chosen as the setting for many iconic scenes in iconic Aussie movies.

Visit the Port Augusta Wadlata Cultural Centre to learn about the region's history and understand the epic undertaking to open up the Eyre Peninsula and Nullarbor. En route, stop in for lunch at the outback town of Kimba and view the world-famous silo art. In the late afternoon, you'll arrive at Coodlie Park Farm Retreat for a BBQ feast and a yarn around the campfire. Spend a highlight night in a unique swag hut in an eco-campground with shower and toilet facilities.

Overnight: Coodlie Park Farm Retreat

Day 4 Coodlie Park to Port Lincoln (approx. 250km day)

After a cooked breakfast, mosey down the wild and rocky western Eyre Peninsula coast, stopping for a view of Locks Well and the Instagram-worthy Talia Caves.

Following morning tea, it's time to meet the makers behind Experience Coffin Bay - Chris and Linda. Soak up the pristine environment as you cruise the bay to a working oyster lease and learn about the oyster industry on the Eyre Peninsula.



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THE ITINERARY

Pluck fresh oysters from straight from the lease, try your hand at shucking, and finally, taste! You will understand why Coffin Bay Oysters are recognised as the world's best and have been known to convert many a non-oyster eater.

With your taste buds wanting more, we'll relax at 1802 Oyster Bar & Restaurant. Enjoy Chef Andy's favourite dishes sampling a range of local produce from the sea and land. After lunch, explore the pristine Coffin Bay National Park, famed for its white sandy beaches and roaming emus and kangaroos. Arrive at Port Lincoln in the mid-afternoon, and after checking-in to your room at the Port Lincoln Hotel, you'll have time to relax. Then you'll meet your guide for dinner at the award-winning restaurant, Del Giorno's.

Overnight: Port Lincoln Hotel

Day 5 Port Lincoln & Surrounds (approx. 150km day)

This morning you have the choice between two different itineraries:

Option 1- One of Australia's best interactive wildlife experiences, swimming with playful Australian sea lions. This half-day cruise to the crystal-clear waters of Seal Cove off Port Lincoln is an Optional Extra guaranteed to be one of the best days of your life. Be amazed as the puppy dogs of the sea welcome your arrival with great excitement! This must be pre-booked and can be purchased at check-out.

Option 2 - If you prefer to stay on dry land, start the day by exploring the breathtakingly beautiful Lincoln National Park. Enjoy a local produce morning tea at Stamford Hill after an invigorating climb. Visit Cape Donnington and the pristine beaches and lookouts on offer.

Then it's back to Port Lincoln to meet the rest of the group

and have lunch at the iconic Fresh Fish Place. No matter which option you choose in the morning, the afternoon looks like this—Glen Forest for up close and personal wildlife encounters and some wine tasting at Lincoln Estate. Head back to the hotel for some free time before settling in for a great evening meal at Sarin's Restaurant at the Port Lincoln Hotel.

Overnight: Port Lincoln Hotel

Day 6 Port Lincoln - Adelaide

After breakfast, we'll jump on the bus to see some stunning coastline at Sleaford Bay and Whalers Way. Visit Mikkira Station, home of a wild koala population, where you can get some fantastic photos before a relaxing lunch of fresh local seafood harvest at the Marina Hotel Restaurant. With a full tummy, board the 'Tesla', a unique electric canal cruiser. Enjoy a tranquil cruise around Port Lincoln's Marina and learn about Australia's largest commercial fishing fleet. We'll finish the tour at the picturesque Boston Bay Winery to meet owner Tony for some wine and coffee tastings. Feeling inspired and satisfied with your amazing six-day adventure, your guide will transfer you to the Port Lincoln Airport for your late afternoon flight back to Adelaide. Upon arrival at Adelaide Airport, make your own onwards travel arrangements.

FIT FOR TRAVEL DECLARATION & ONLINE CHECK IN

TOUR GUIDE VS. TOUR LEADER

Tour Guide

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction in which he or she is guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves the group at the end of the tour, they do not travel with the group.

Tour Leader

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides in each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village, and offer information on the place visited on the bus, however they are not required to have specific knowledge on art, architecture, or history. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when particularly required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

South Australia has an average maximum temperature of 29°C in summer and 15 - 16°C in winter. The best time to visit Adelaide is from March to May and September through November, during the city's fall and spring.

COACH TOUR

Meals

All meals are included in the tour, for all other meals; the tour leader (when available) will offer assistance with reservations, suggestions and directions to local restaurants. It is your responsibility to notify TripADeal of any dietary requests/requirements.
