Day 1 Australia - Tokyo, Japan - Arrive Tokyo

Today depart from either Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane, Adelaide or Perth to Tokyo, Japan.

Upon arrival in Tokyo please make your way to your centrally located accommodation in the Shibuya district.

There aren't many places on Earth that blend ancient tradition and the ultra modern quite like Tokyo. Centuries-old gardens and cobblestone laneways live in perfect harmony with soaring skyscrapers and dazzling neon lights. Get immersed in an unrivalled dining scene, fashionable boutiques, and endless cultural encounters in this ever-evolving city.

Famous for its shopping and nightlife, Shibuya is a major commercial and business centre. It houses the two busiest railway stations in the world, Shinjuku Station and Shibuya Station. The shopping and entertainment precinct is always a hive of activity, with locals and visitors all looking to snap up a bargain in the multi storey department stores, enjoy delicious ramen, or unleash the pop star within at a local karaoke bar.

Shizuoka's rich history owes a lot to the trade that came in through Shimizu Port. The best way to view its splendour is from the sea. Cruises take in the port itself as well as Miho Pine Grove, Nihondaira Plateau, and Izu Peninsula. Other sights include S-Pulse Dream Plaza, a shopping mall complex with a cinema and a Ferris wheel.

On clear days, particularly in winter, Mount Fuji (Fuji-san in Japanese) is visible from as far as Tokyo, 60 miles away. When Japan's highest mountain is capped with snow, it's a picture-postcard perfect volcanic cone. One of the best-known symbols of Japan, this iconic mountain has been considered sacred since ancient times and was even forbidden to women

Day 6 Osaka (Kyoto) - Arrive 12pm

Today arrive in Osaka and overnight in port. Enjoy a day at leisure in Osaka or take a quick train ride to the nearby city of Tokyo.

Osaka is Japan's second largest metropolitan area after Tokyo. It has been the economic powerhouse of the Kansai Region for many centuries. Osaka was formerly known as Naniwa. Before the Nara Period, when the capital used to be moved with the reign of each new emperor, Naniwa was once Japan's capital city, the first one ever known.

In the 16th century, Toyotomi Hideyoshi chose Osaka as the location for his castle, and the city may have become Japan's political capital if Tokugawa Ieyasu had not terminated the Toyotomi lineage after Hideyoshi's death and moved his government to distant Edo (Tokyo).

They also trek to Tōrin-ji, a 1614 Buddhist temple that survived the 1771 tsunami to become Okinawa's oldest wooden building. Get out of town to experience the unspoiled beaches, dazzling waters, coral reefs, palm forests, pineapple plantations, and

subtropical vistas that ring the island.

Seat Selection & Frequent Flyer Points
