THE ITINERARY

Day 1 Arrive Queenstown - Lake Wakatipu Cruise & BBQ Dinner

Upon arrival into Queenstown, make your own way to your centrally located hotel. This afternoon experience stunning views as you cruise across Lake Wakatipu on the iconic TSS Earnslaw and discover one of Queenstown's most popular dining destinations - Walter Peak High Country Farm.

Cruise aboard the historic TSS Earnslaw across to Walter Peak High Country Farm. Once at the lakeside Colonel's Homestead Restaurant, savour the delicious aromas as the chef uses the best of local produce for a barbecue dinner. Overlooking Lake Wakatipu and Queenstown's alpine scenery, the Colonel's Homestead is the perfect place to spend a few hours with an entertaining farm demonstration also included or you can explore the beautiful lakeside gardens.

Please note: the TSS Earnslaw cruise departs at approx. 6:00pm and it is advisable to arrive in Queenstown no later than 3:00pm.

Day 2 Milford Sound

This morning, travel by coach from Queenstown along the Milford Road, which is one of the finest alpine drives in the world. The scenery is exceptional, ranging from broad grassy flats, dense rainforest, and towering mountains to glacial lakes and alpine herb fields. Get up close and personal with Milford Sound on a leisurely cruise of this spectacular fiord. From thundering waterfalls to sky-high mountains to lush rainforests, Milford has it all. Experience the spray of a waterfall as you cruise close to sheer rock faces. Informative, participative and relaxed, this is the perfect way to experience

Milford Sound to the fullest.

After the cruise, transfer by coach to the charming town of Te Anau.

Day 3 Te Anau Glowworm Caves

Experience a mysterious underground world with a guided cave tour past the rushing water of an underground stream before drifting in silent darkness beneath the luminous shimmer of hundreds of glowworms. Your trip to the Te Anau Glowworm Caves begins with a cruise to the western shores of Lake Te Anau on one of the purpose-built scenic cruise vessels. Deep inside the caves, beyond the roar of the water, you will be taken by small boat into a silent hidden grotto inhabited by hundreds of glowworms, unique to New Zealand. In the subterranean darkness, they produce a glittering display that is nothing short of extraordinary.

Day 4 Doubtful Sound

Doubtful Sound is a beautiful fiord; three times longer than Milford Sound, it has a surface area ten times larger with twisting arms. With its rugged peaks, verdant rainforest and twisting, hidden inlets, Doubtful Sound will take your breath away. There's no direct road access, so the only way you can get to Doubtful Sound is a cruise across the picturesque Lake Manapouri, followed by a bus trip over Wilmot Pass - New Zealand's most expensive (and majestic) road.

Pause along the way to experience the dense Fiordland rainforest and view Doubtful Sound glistening below. This

isolation makes this fiord a very special place, only those in the know get to see. Once you arrive, you will board the Patea Explorer for a 3 hour (approximately) cruise on Doubtful Sound - a spectacular pristine fiord. During the cruise the knowledgeable and friendly nature guides will share with you their passion for the region. They're always ready to answer questions, point out landmarks and provide all the information about the varied wildlife you may see, including dolphins, fur seals and the rare Fiordland crested penguin.

Day 5 Te Anau to Queenstown

After check-out this morning, you will transfer by coach back to Queenstown. Enjoy this afternoon and evening at your leisure to explore the vibrant town of Queenstown.

CLIMATE & AVERAGE TEMPERATURES

November

Spring can be a bit unpredictable in Queenstown. One day can be bright and sunny, and the next can be rainy or cloudy. Temperatures are also erratic, ranging from 6 degrees to 18 degrees.

December - February

The best time to visit Queenstown is the summer when the long, sunny days make outdoor excursions enjoyable. Temperature ranges from 8 degrees to 21 degrees.
