October is the last really warm month in Hawaii, however, the rains will just be starting to pick up as the wet season approaches. Expect average temperatures of 29°C.

Tahiti / French Polynesia

October brings about the end of the dry season. Daily temperatures will range from the high 20's to low 30's.

October/November is a pleasant time to travel in New Zealand, as it's late spring. Average daytime high temperatures in spring range from 19°C in the Bay of Islands and 18°C in Auckland.

FLIGHTS

Seat Selection & Frequent Flyer Points:

At TripADeal we do not arrange seat selection. It is important to highlight that some Airlines do not allow pre-selected seats.
