
THE OFFER

Spectacular cliffside villages, colourful seaside taverns, and awe-inspiring ancient wonders; the Greek Islands are proof of love at first sight. This easy-going 12 day trip is a chance to uncover the best of this iconic destination, with ample time to sit back, relax, and explore these incredible Islands at your own pace.

Begin in Athens and enjoy a city highlights tour including the Parthenon and Acropolis Museum, then travel by ferry and revel in the Glamorous Mykonos. Here you'll find breathtaking views of stunning multi-coloured cliff faces, and a vibrant dining scene.

You will then be transported by ferry to the sun-kissed island of Santorini. Witness blue-domed churches and idyllic sunsets, before embarking on your journey to discover picturesque villages and golden beaches in Naxos.

This trip also includes return international flights, nine nights premium hotel accommodation, ferry transfers between the islands, daily buffet breakfasts and more.





THE ITINERARY

Day 1: Australia or New Zealand - Athens, Greece

Depart for Athens in beautiful Greece. Fly with Qatar Airways, Emirates or a oneworld partner.

Please note: Due to flight scheduling and availability, some customers may be required to depart on day 2, to arrive on day 2. Flight times will be indicated on your final documentation, which you will receive 4-6 weeks prior to departure.

Meals included: In-Flight

Day 2: Welcome to Athens, Greece

Upon arrival into Athens be met by a tour representative and transferred to the hotel. If it is too early for check-in, then luggage can be stored at the hotel whilst you explore the wonders of this city at your own pace.

Overnight: Ibis Styles Athens Routes Hotel, Athens (or similar)

Meals included: None

Day 3: Athens City Tour

After breakfast, enjoy an Athens city highlights tour, including a visit to the UNESCO listed world heritage site of The Acropolis. The Acropolis is an ancient citadel located on a high rocky outcrop above the city of Athens. It's home to several ancient buildings of great architectural and historic significance, the most famous being the Parthenon. Whilst here, enjoy a visit to the new Acropolis Museum.

Overnight: Ibis Styles Athens Routes Hotel, Athens (or similar)

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 4: Athens - Mykonos

Today, transfer to Piraeus Port and take the ferry to beautiful Mykonos. Upon arrival in Mykonos, transfer to the hotel, and enjoy the rest of the day at leisure.

Mykonos is one of the most popular and glamorous Greek isles, well known for its cosmopolitan atmosphere, whitewashed houses, beautiful beaches and sensational bars and restaurants. The Old Town of Chora - also known as Mykonos Town - has many shopping and dining options.

Overnight: Adonis Hotel, Mykonos (or similar)

Day 5: Enjoy a day to yourself to explore Mykonos at your own pace

Enjoy a day to yourself to explore Mykonos. Why not take time to explore the beaches and coves or indulge in the many dining options available. Be sure to try some local seafood in a traditional Taverna.

Overnight: Adonis Hotel, Mykonos (or similar)

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 6: Mykonos - Santorini

Today, transfer to the port for the ferry to Santorini. Upon arrival, be transferred to the hotel. If the room is not ready for check in, then baggage can be stored at the hotel.

For the next two days enjoy all that spectacular Santorini has to offer - breathtaking views, stunning multi-coloured cliff faces, fantastic beaches, and a vibrant dining scene.

City Tax

Greek accommodation tax

The Greek Ministries of Tourism & Finance have introduced an Accommodation Tax at the sum of €0.50 - €4 (approximately \$0.80 - \$6 AUD) per room per night with effect from 1st January 2018. This Tourism Tax will apply no matter if the booking was made before or after the announcement. Please take note that the tax will be collected directly from the accommodation establishment upon check in.

Accommodation Terminology Use

4-Star

A 4-star property is comfortable, well-appointed and provides a good quality of service and level of comfort. Amenities such as restaurants, luggage handling etc are limited per property. Guest rooms are stylishly decorated and include a range of enhanced amenities. Properties in the 4-star category usually require public transport, taxi or rideshare to the centre of town.

Tour guide Vs. Tour Leader

Tour Guide:

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on the history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction where they are guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves it at the end of the tour; they do not travel with the group.

Tour Leader:

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the

smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides at each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village and offer information on the place visited on the bus. However, they are not required to have specific art, architecture, or historical knowledge. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and, if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please note: Tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.

Climate & Average Temperatures

Greece

The best time to visit Athens and the Greek Islands begins in April, when the mean temperature is 21 °C degrees and rainfall is minimal and continues on through to October with average temperatures ranging from 21-29 °C. Days are sunny and clear.

Flights

Seat Selection & Frequent Flyer Points:

We do not arrange seat selection for you. It is important to highlight that some Airlines do not allow pre-selected seats. We strongly suggest you contact the Airline directly with seating allocation requirements and or arrive at the airport earlier to arrange your seating. While we do not add frequent flyer member details to bookings, you can do this directly with the airline once you have your flight information.

Passport Validity:

Customers must provide valid passport details either at the time of purchase or no later than 45 days before the departure date. Failure to do so may result in the cancellation of the booking. Customers will be responsible for any costs and fees incurred in this instance.

Coach Tour

Meals:

Daily breakfast is included in the package. For meals not included, the tour leader (when available) will offer assistance with reservations, suggestions and directions to local restaurants. It is your responsibility to notify Qantas Tours of any dietary requests/requirements. Please

note: We will do our best to meet your requests/requirements; however, we cannot guarantee that we will always be able to.

Luggage:

You will be responsible for all your personal belongings whilst on tour. You must carry your own luggage from the vehicle to the hotel room and back to the vehicle. The driver will assist with the uploading and offloading of bags from the vehicle.

Mobility:

If you would love to travel with Qantas Tours and require wheelchair access please contact our friendly sales and service team to inquire on your behalf.

Fitness Level Required:

A leisurely level of fitness will be required.

This is described as light walking, including up multiple stairs, and occasional hiking, may involve uneven surfaces. Able to travel unassisted and get on and off vehicles and small boats. Suitable for most fitness levels and mobility.

Gratuities / Tipping:

Land

Gratuities (tips) are not included for the services of the tour leader (when available) and driver throughout the tour. The recommended tip is €5 per person per day. This covers the guide/leader and the driver and will be collected on tour.

Please note: tipping for services provided is always a matter of personal discretion; however, please be aware that many locals consider tipping part of their normal remuneration, and they may approach you for payment; there's no need to be intimidated by the request.

Sightseeing:

Please note: If entrance to a site is affected by changes in operating hours or public holiday closures, your itinerary, where possible, may be adjusted, or a similar activity will be offered in its place (subject to availability).

Shopping:

Shopping overseas can be a daunting and confusing experience, especially when there is a language barrier. Please be very cautious when

foreign currencies and prices are involved. If paying by credit card, please pay close attention to the amount you are being charged and keep all your receipts.

Do not make any purchases you are not comfortable with or feel pressured into. If you are uncertain or need assistance with the language barrier, please seek assistance from your Tour Guide/Leader.

Visas

A tourist visa is not required for Europe for stays up to 90 days if travelling on an Australian or New Zealand passport.

Important:

Visa rules may have changed since Covid-19.

Some countries and airlines may require you to obtain an additional visa before arrival. Please check with the nearest embassy, consulate or immigration department of the destination you're entering.

Please note: Passengers who are not Australian citizens must also check with the respective consulate or visa agency to determine what their visa requirements are and what personal identification is required.

It is also important to note that some areas of employment, such as journalism, government authorities and charity organisations, may have additional restrictions in applying for Visas. This may, in turn, affect the type of application required.

Schedule of fees

Voluntary Changes
